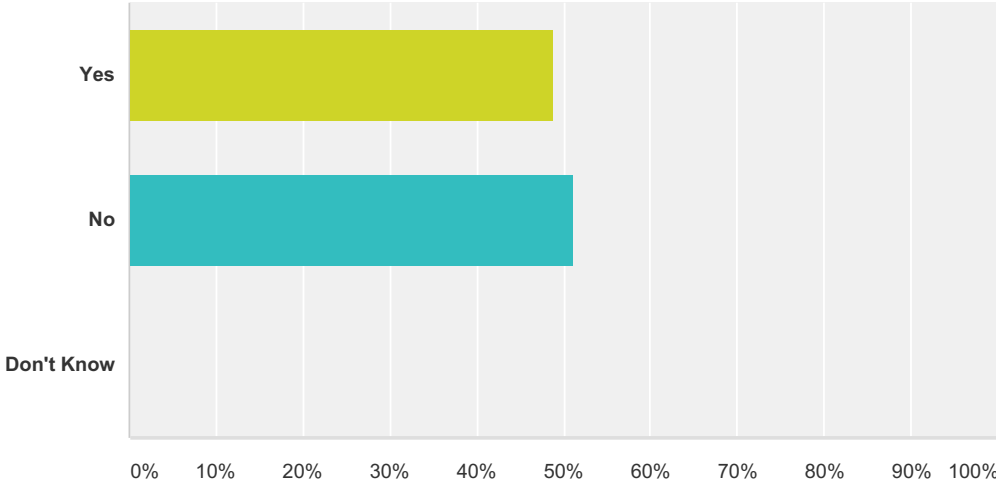


Q1 Have you experienced crime and/or anti-social behaviour (ASB) that has impacted on your business in the last 12 months?

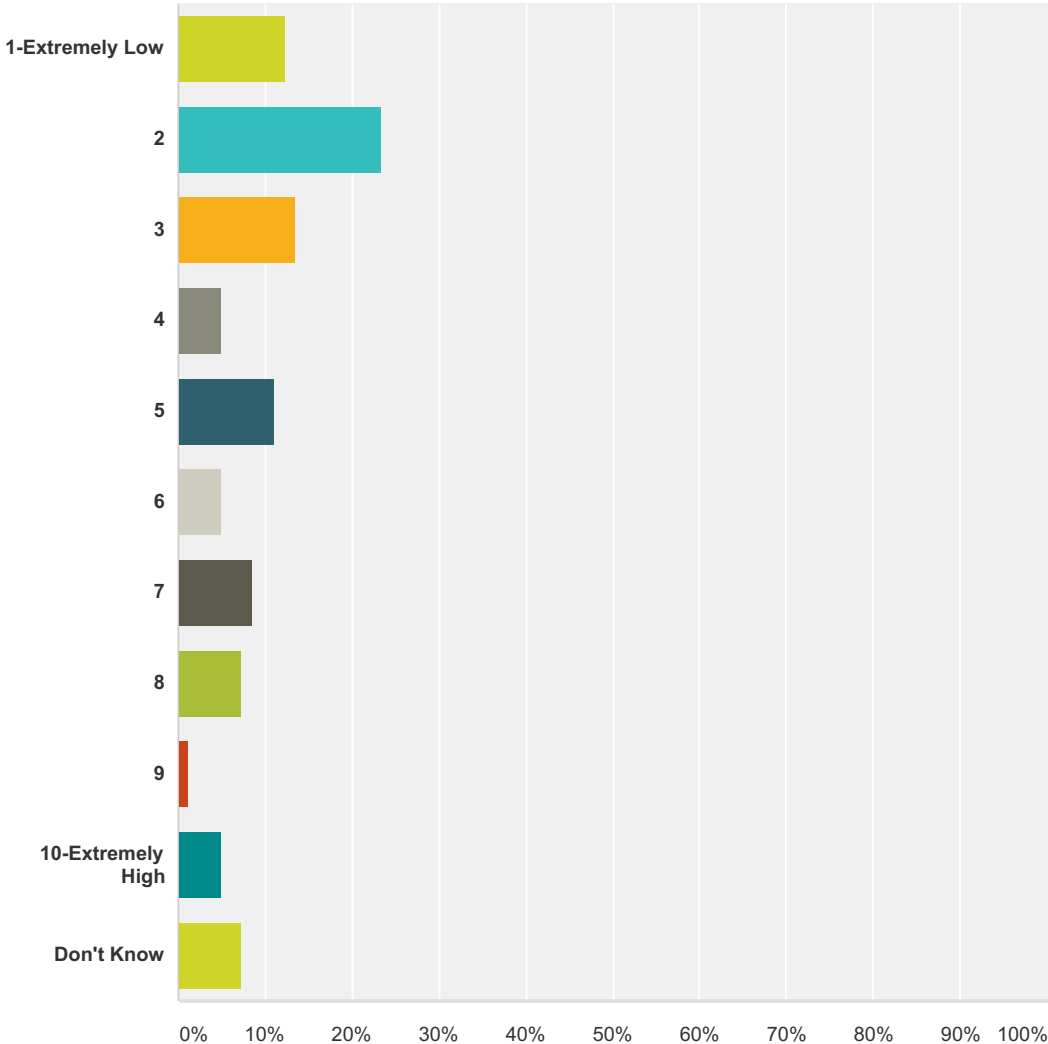

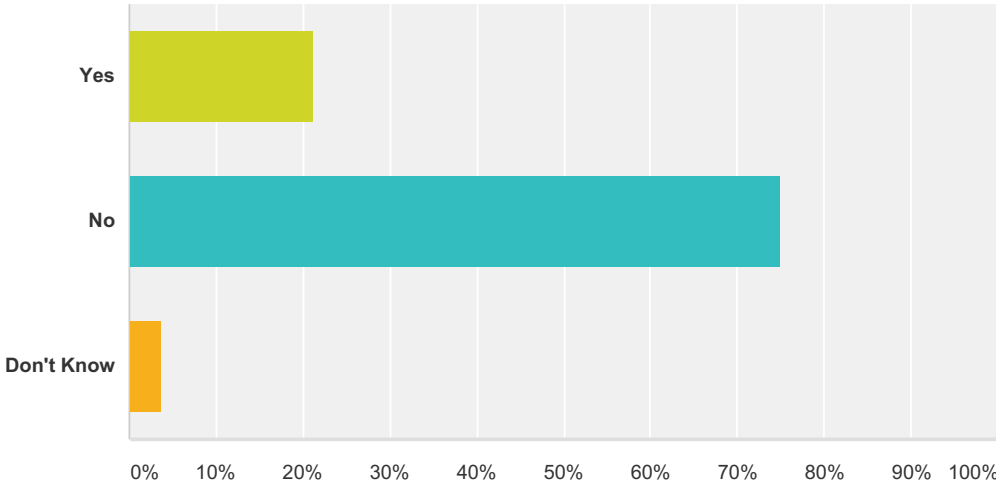

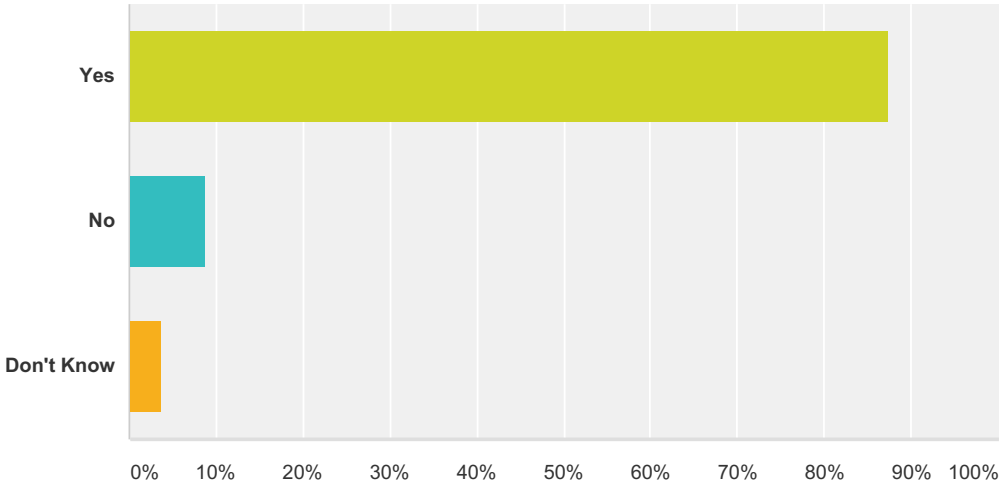

Q5 As a business, have you taken any crime prevention measures?

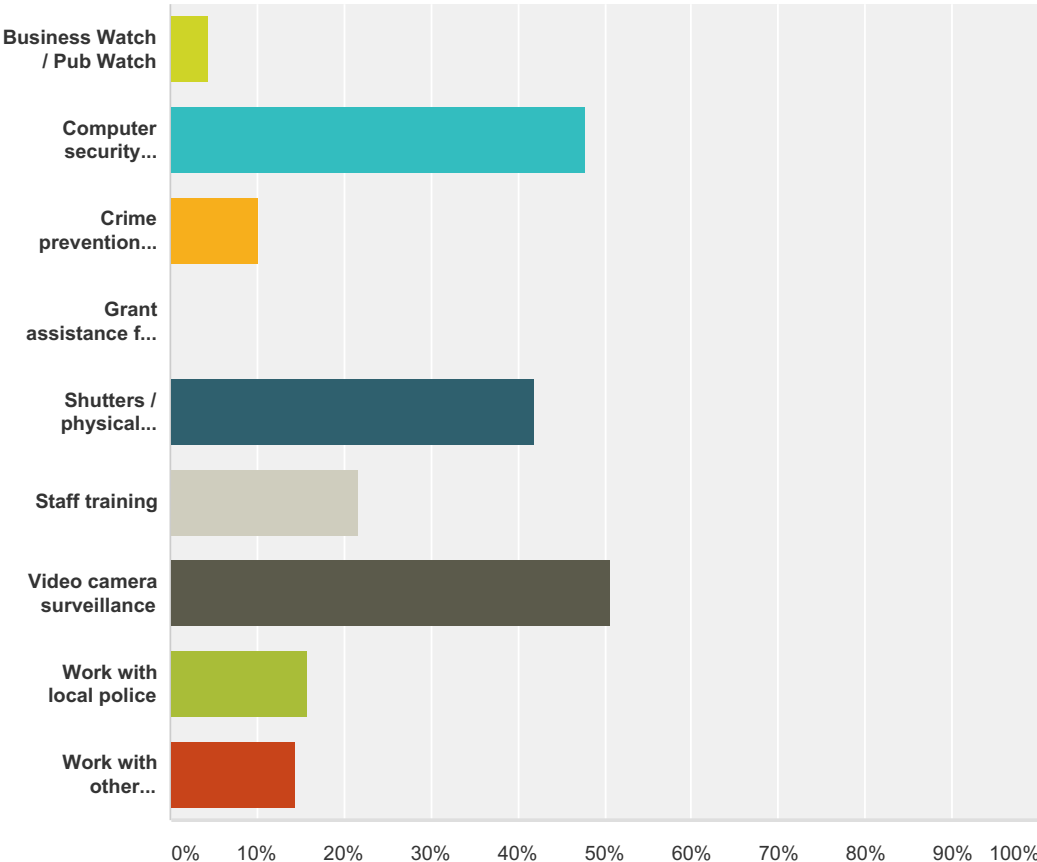

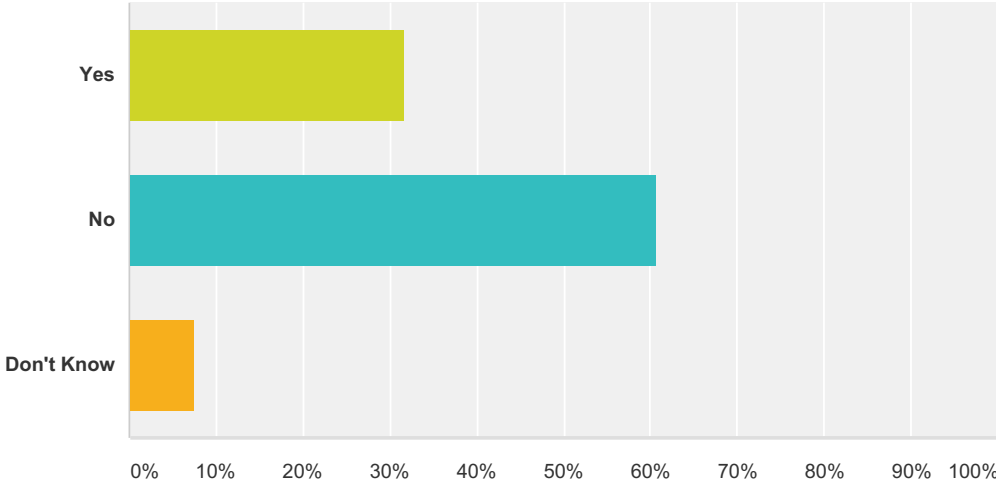

Q7 Do crime and ASB levels have a negative effect on the investment decisions of your business?

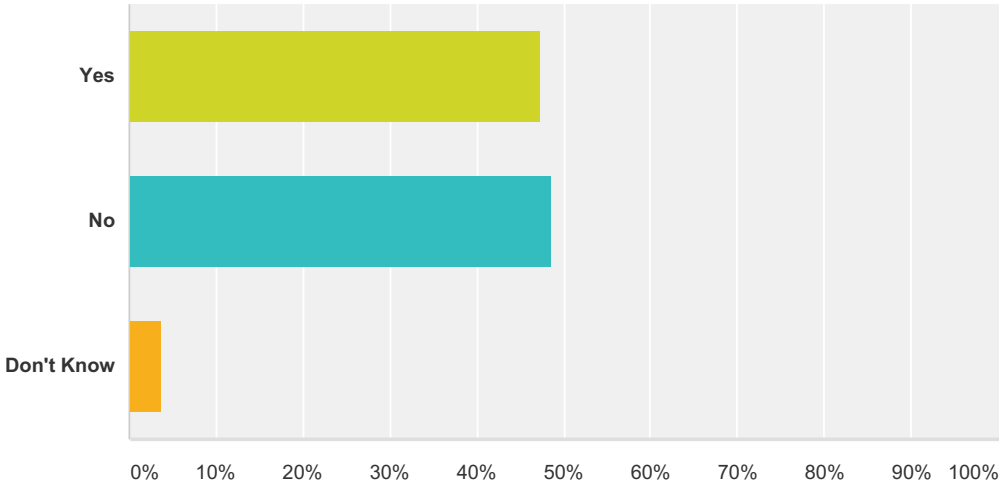

Q8 Do crime and ASB levels impact on where you choose to locate your business?

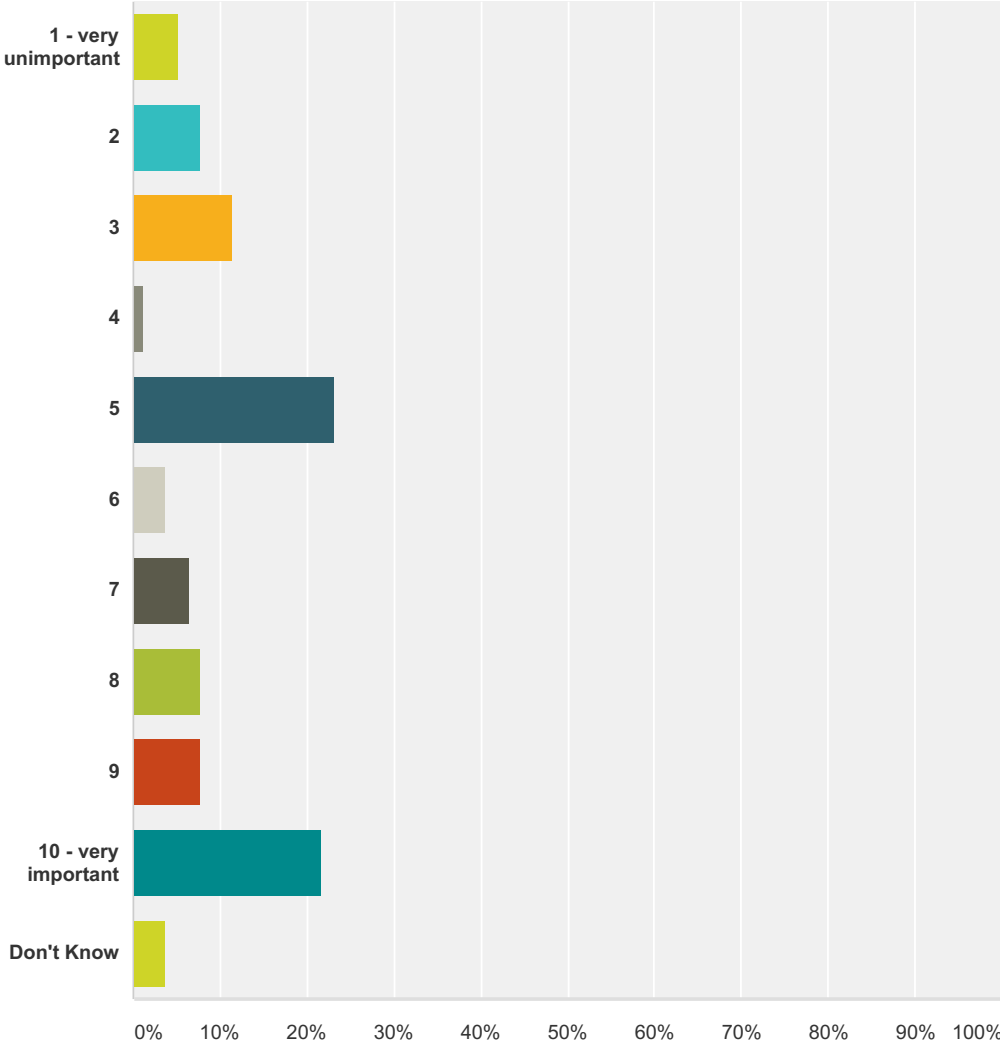

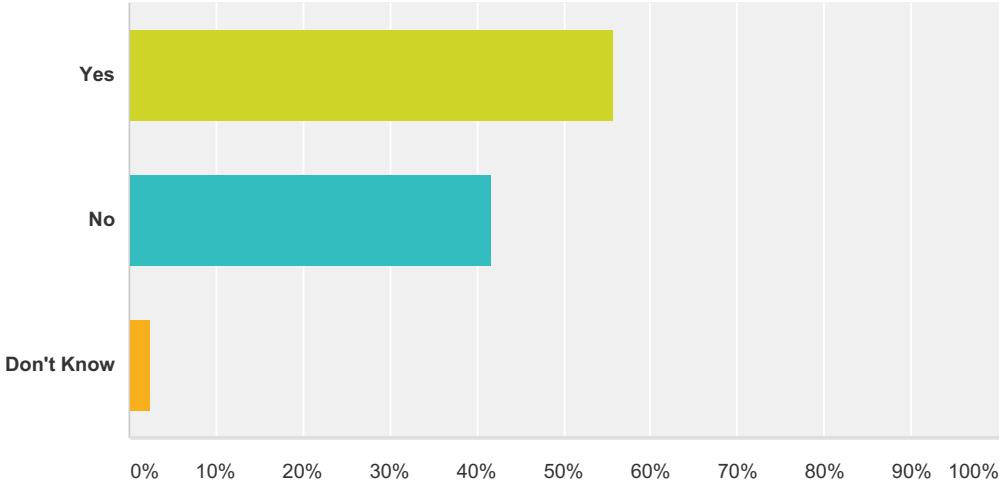

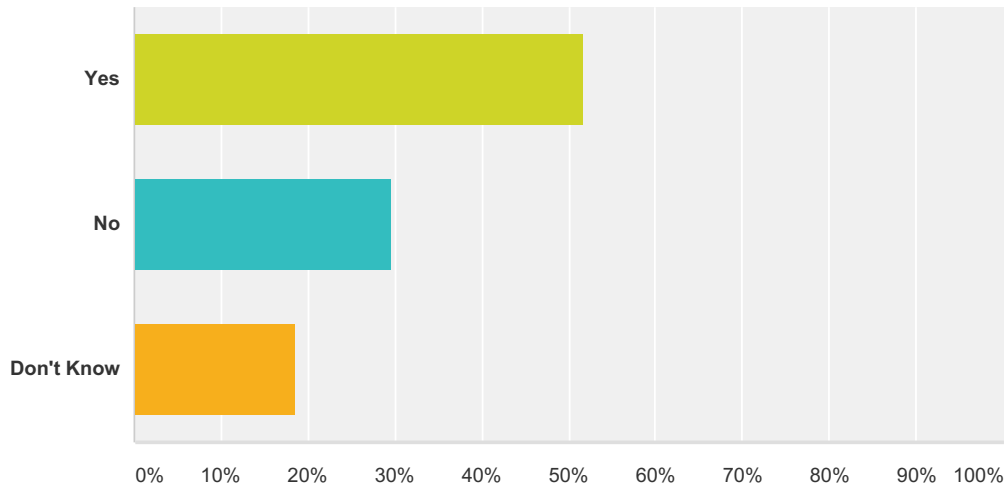

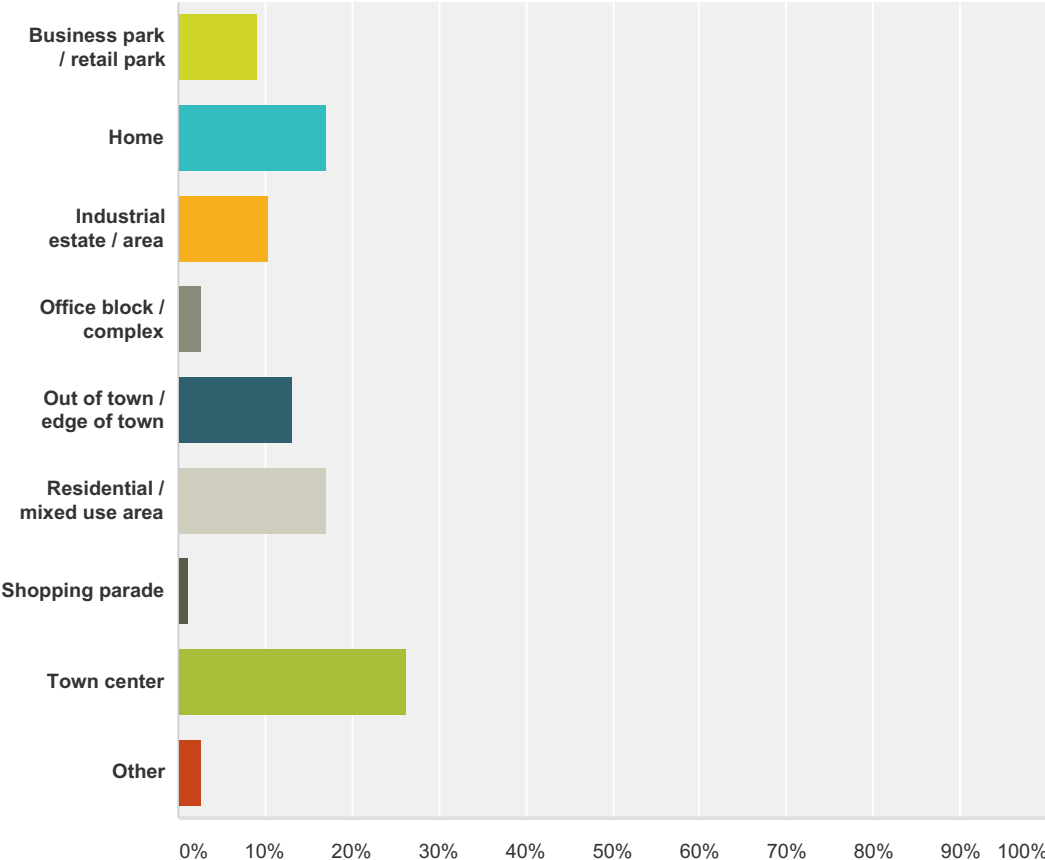

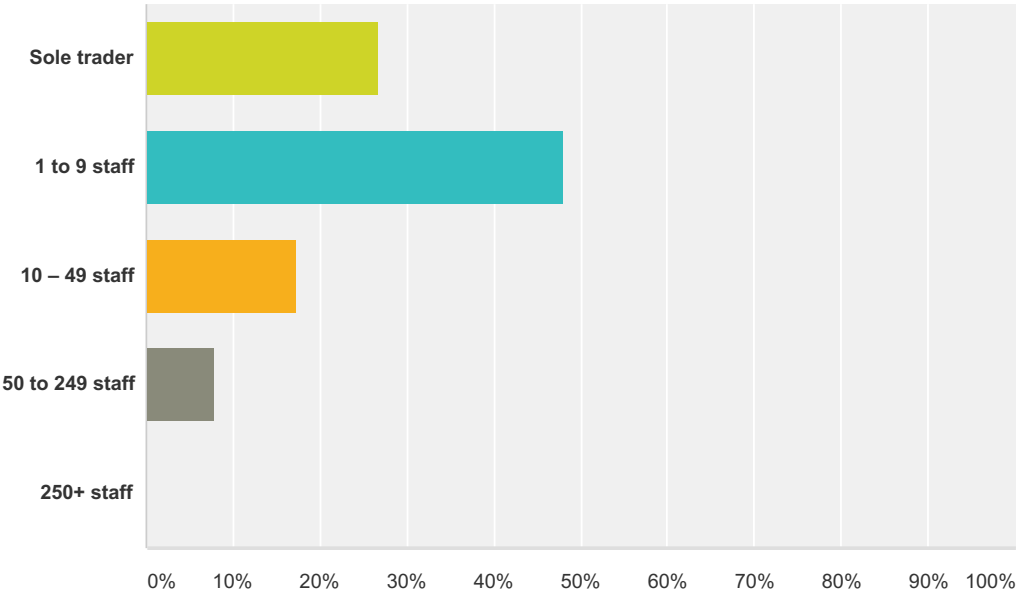

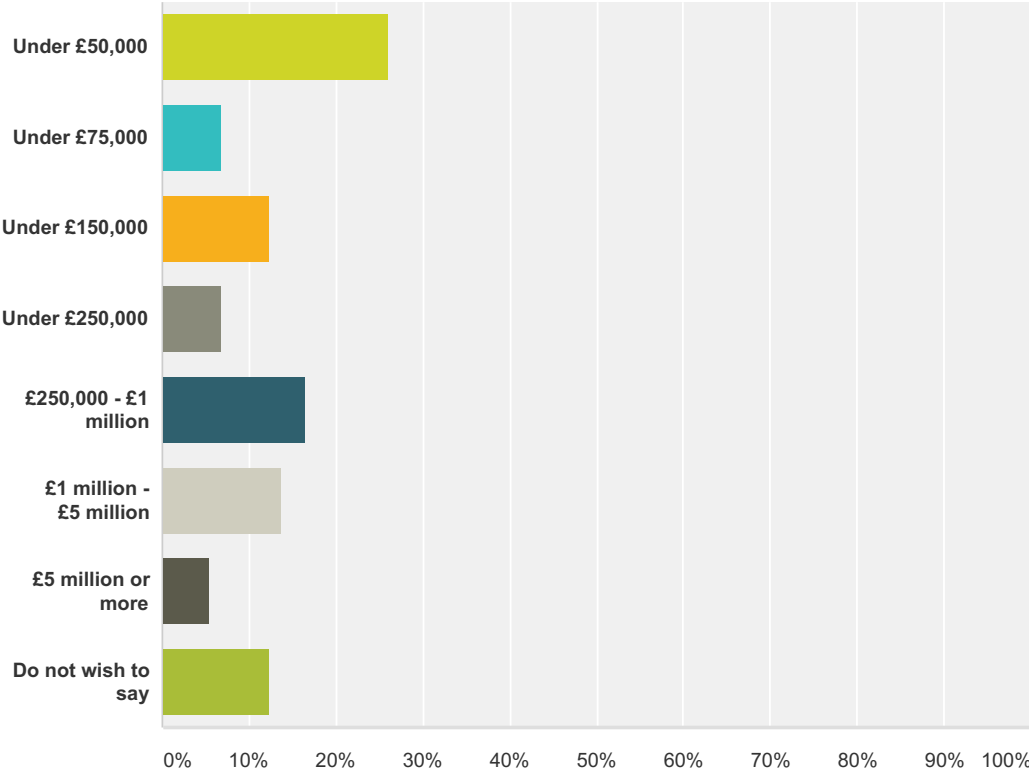

Q17 What is the estimated annual turnover of your business?

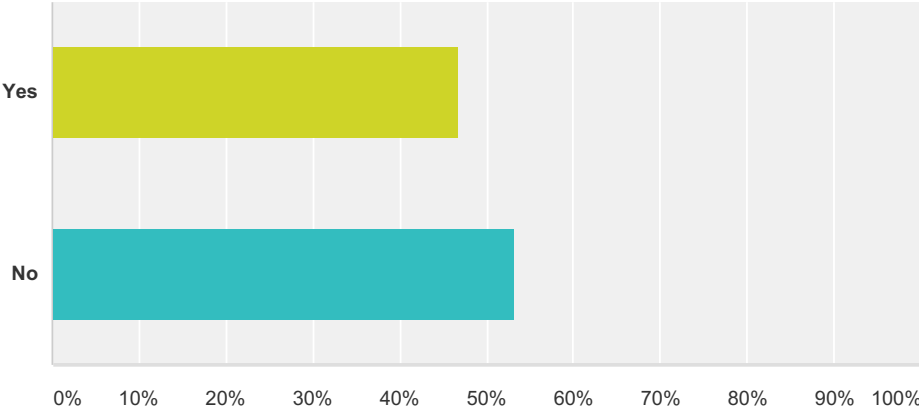
